23	SECTION 1. Arkan	sas Code § 5-73-322 is amended to	read as follows:

26	(a) As used in t	his section:	
27	<u>(1) "Hospi</u>	tal" means the facilities of an in	stitution licensed,
28	certified, or approved	by the Division of Health Faciliti	les Services of the
29	Department of Health as	s a hospital that is primarily enga	aged in providing to
30	patients diagnostic and	therapeutic services for medical	diagnosis,
31	treatment, and care of	persons with an injury, disability	or illness, by or

5	(B) "Public university, public college, or community
6	college" includes without limitation a public technical institute in a county
7	with a population of at least two hundred thousand (200,000) according to the
8	last federal decennial census and that borders another state.
9	$\frac{(B)(C)}{(B)}$ "Public university, public college, or community
10	college" does not include a private university or private college solely
11	because:
12	(i) Students attending the private university or
13	private college receive state-supported scholarships; or
14	(ii) The private university or private college
15	voluntarily reports to the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board; and
16	(2)(3)(A) "Staff member" means a person who is not enrolled as a
17	full-time student at the university, college, or community college and is
18	either employed by the university, college, or community college:

23	(b) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on
24	the grounds, whether owned or leased by the public university, public
25	college, or community college, of the public university, public college, or
26	community college where he or she is employed unless otherwise prohibited by
27	this section or § 5-73-306 if he or she is a staff member and completes the
28	required training under subsection (1) of this section.+
29	(1) He or she is a staff member; and
30	(2)(A) The governing board of the public university, public
31	college, or community college does not adopt a policy expressly disallowing
32	the carrying of a concealed handgun by staff members in the buildings or on
33	the grounds of the public university, public college, or community college
34	and posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
35	(B) A governing board of the public university, public
36	college, or community college may adopt differing policies for the carrying

of a concealed handgun by staff members for different campuses, areas of a
campus, or individual buildings of the public university, public college, or
community college for which the governing board is responsible.

- (C) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun by staff members into the public university, public college, or community college expires one (1) year after the date of adoption and must be readopted each year by the governing board of the public university, public college, or community college to remain in effect.
  - (c) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college where he or she is employed unless otherwise prohibited by this section or § 5-73-306 if:
    - (1) He or she is a staff member; and

- (2) (A) The private university or private college does not adopt a policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college and posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
- 18 policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the
  19 buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college
  20 shall post notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
  - (C) A private university or private college that adopts a policy only allowing carrying of a concealed handgun under this section shall post notices as described in § 5-73-306(18) and subsection (k) of this section.
  - (d) The storage of a handgun in a university or college-operated student dormitory or residence hall is prohibited under § 5-73-119(c).
  - (e)(1) The governing board of a public university, public college, or public community college that operates a public medical school may adopt a policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun by a staff member in the buildings or on the grounds of the public medical school that are adjacent to or are up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) mile of an associated public hospital.
  - (2) This subsection does not limit the governing board of a public university, public college, or public community college from tailoring its policy to permit the carrying of a concealed handgun into certain public hospital or public medical school facilities within the one-half-mile radius.

1	(3) A policy adopted under this subsection is invalid until
2	public notices as described under § 5-73-306(18) are posted in and around the
3	premises of the public medical school and associated public hospital that are
4	subject to the policy.
5	(f)(1) The governing board of a public university, public college, or
6	public community college may adopt a policy expressly disallowing the
7	carrying of a concealed handgun by a staff member in the buildings or on the
8	grounds of the public university, public college, or public community college
9	that are adjacent to or are up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) mile of a
10	federally owned and operated presidential library.
11	(2) This subsection does not limit the governing board of a
12	public university, public college, or public community college from tailoring
13	its policy to permit the carrying of a concealed handgun into certain
14	facilities where carrying a concealed handgun is not otherwise prohibited by
15	federal law within the one-half-mile radius.
16	(3) A policy adopted under this subsection is invalid until
17	public notices as described under § 5-73-306(18) are posted in and around the
18	premises of the public university, public college, or public community
19	college that are adjacent to or up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) mile
20	of a federally owned and operated presidential library that are subject to
21	the policy.
22	(g) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun under
23	subsection (e) or subsection (f) of this section expires one (l) year after
24	the date of adoption and shall be readopted each year by the governing board
25	to remain in effect.
26	(h)(1) A staff member who is a licensee and who may carry a concealed
27	handgun on the campus of a public university, public college, or public
28	community college under this section may not carry a concealed handgun:
29	(A) Into a licensed daycare or childcare facility that is
30	located on the campus of the public university, public college, or public
31	community college;
32	(B) During a meeting conducted for the purpose of job
33	performance, tenure issues, personnel evaluations, grievances, disciplinary

10	(A) Legal limitations on the use of firearms;
11	(B) Fundamental use of firearms, including firearm safety
12	drills, tactics, and required qualification on an approved course of fire;
13	(C) Active shooter training;
14	(D) Active shooter simulation scenarios;
15	(E) Trauma care;
16	(F) Defensive tactics;
17	(G) Weapon retention; and
18	(H) Handgun safety and maintenance.
19	(2) A training program administered under this subsection shall
20	consist of at least sixteen (16) hours.
21	(3) A training program under this subsection shall have
22	comparable standards to an active shooter or related training program
23	administered by the commission.
24	(m)(1) Before carrying a concealed handgun in the buildings and on the
25	grounds of a public university, public college, or community college under
26	this section, a staff member shall notify the campus police department or
27	another law enforcement agency having jurisdiction in the absence of a campus
28	police department in writing of his or her intent to carry a concealed
29	handgun in the buildings and on the grounds of the public university, public
30	college, or community college.
31	(2) The written notification required under this subsection is
32	exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-
33	<u>105.</u>
34	(n)(1) Unless carrying a concealed handgun is a requirement of the
35	staff member's job description, the carrying of a concealed handgun under
36	this section is a personal choice made by the staff member and not a

1	requirement of the employing public university, public college, or community		
2	college.		
3	(2) A staff member who carries a concealed handgun in the		
4	buildings and on the grounds of a public university, public college, or		
5	community college at which the staff member is employed is not:		
6	(A) Acting in the course of or scope of his or her		
7	employment when carrying or using a concealed handgun;		
8	(B) Entitled to worker's compensation benefits for		
9	injuries arising from his or her carrying or his or her use of a concealed		
10	<u>handgun;</u>		
11	(C) Immune from personal liability with respect to use or		
12	carrying of a concealed handgun; or		
13	(D) Permitted to carry a concealed handgun openly or in		
14	any other manner in which the concealed handgun is visible to ordinary		
15	observation.		
16	(3) A public university, public college, or community college is		
17	immune from claims for monetary damages arising from or related to the staff		
18	member's use of, or failure to use, a concealed handgun, if the staff member		
19	is employed by the public university, public college, or community college		
20	against whom the claim is filed and the staff member elects to carry the		
21	concealed handgun under this section.		
22			
23	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Training program.</u>		
24	The Department of Arkansas State Police shall promulgate rules to		
25	design a training program described under Section 1 of the act within ninety		
26	(90) days of the effective date of this act.		
27			
28	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Effective date.</u>		
29	The effective date of this act is September 1, 2017.
