- 2 (1) The person is in his or her own dwelling or place of
- 3 business or on property in which he or she has a possessory or proprietary
- 4 interest, except upon the property of a public or private institution of
- 5 higher learning;
- 6 (2) The person is a law enforcement officer, correctional
- 7 officer, or member of the armed forces acting in the course and scope of his
- 8 or her official duties;
- 9 (3) The person is assisting a law enforcement officer,
- 10 correctional officer, or member of the armed forces acting in the course and
- ll scope of his or her official duties pursuant to the direction or request of
- 12 the law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or member of the armed
- 13 forces;
- 14 (4) The person is a <del>licensed</del> <u>registered commissioned</u> security

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2 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-73-120 is amended to read as follows: 3 5-73-120. Carrying a weapon.

- (a) A person commits the offense of carrying a weapon if he or she knowingly possesses a handgun, knife, or club on or about his or her person, in a vehicle occupied by him or her, or otherwise readily available for use with a purpose to attempt to employ the handgun, knife, or club as a weapon against a person.
  - (b) As used in this section:
- (1) "Club" means any instrument that is specially designed, 10 11 made, or adapted for the purpose of inflicting serious physical injury or 12

death by striking, including a blackjack, billie, and sap;

- 13 (2) "Handgun" means any firearm with a barrel length of less 14 than twelve inches (12") that is designed, made, or adapted to be fired with 15 one (1) hand; and
- 16 (3) "Journey" means travel beyond the county in which a person 17 lives; and
- 18 (3)(A)(4) "Knife" means any bladed hand instrument three inches 19 (3") or longer that is capable of inflicting serious physical injury or death 20 by cutting or stabbing.,
- 21 (B) "Knife" includes including a dirk, a sword or spear in 22 a cane,  $\underline{a}$  razor,  $\underline{an}$  ice pick,  $\underline{a}$  throwing star,  $\underline{a}$  switchblade, and  $\underline{a}$  butterfly 23 knife.
- 24 It is a defense to a prosecution permissible to carry a handgun 25 under this section that if at the time of the act of carrying a weapon:
- 26 (1) The person is in his or her own dwelling, or place of 27 business, or on property in which he or she has a possessory or proprietary 28 interest;
- 29 (2) The person is a law enforcement officer, correctional 30 officer, or member of the armed forces acting in the course and scope of his 31 or her official duties;
- 32 (3) The person is assisting a law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or member of the armed forces acting in the course and 33 scope of his or her official duties pursuant to the direction or request of 34 35 the law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or member of the armed 36 forces;

1	(4) The person is carrying a weapon when upon a journey, unless		
2	the journey is through a commercial airport when presenting at the security		
3	checkpoint in the airport or is in the person's checked baggage and is not a		
4	lawfully declared weapon;		
5	(5) The person is a licensed registered commissioned security		
6	guard acting in the course and scope of his or her duties;		
7	(6) The person is hunting game with a handgun that may be hunted		
8	with a handgun under rules and regulations of the Arkansas State Game and		
9	Fish Commission or is en route to or from a hunting area for the purpose of		
10	hunting game with a handgun;		
11	(7) The person is a certified law enforcement officer; or		
12	(8) The person is in a motor vehicle is in possession of a		
13	concealed handgun and the person has a valid license to carry a concealed		
14	weapon pursuant to handgun under § 5-73-301 et seq., or recognized under § 5-		
15	73-321 and is not in a prohibited place as defined by § 5-73-306; or		
16	(9) The person is in possession of a handgun and is a retired		
17	law enforcement officer with a valid concealed carry authorization issued		
18	under federal or state law.		
19	(d) <del>(1) Any person who carries a weapon into an establishment that</del>		
20	sells alcoholic beverages is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine o		
21	not more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or imprisonment for		
22	not more than one (1) year, or both.		
23	(2) Otherwise, carrying Carrying a weapon is a Class A misdemeanor.
