DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-2-9.

Synopsis: Right of state officer to carry a handgun in the capitol. Defines "state officer" as an individual who holds the elected office of attorney general, secretary of state, state comptroller, or treasurer of state. Provides that a state officer who meets certain requirements has the right to carry a handgun within the state capitol building and on the property of the state capitol complex.

Effective: July 1, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

4	Chapter 9. Handguns
5	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "state officer" means an
6	individual who holds one (1) of the following elected offices:
7	(1) Attorney general.
8	(2) Secretary of state.
9	(3) State comptroller.
10	(4) Treasurer of state.
11	The term does not include an employee of one of the offices listed
12	in subdivisions (1) through (4), other than the elected office holder.
13	Sec. 2. A state officer who:
14	(1) possesses a valid Indiana license to carry a handgun; and
15	(2) is otherwise permitted to possess a handgun;
16	has the right to carry a handgun within the state capitol building
17	and on the property of the state capitol complex.
