MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 14 be amended to read as follows:

rage 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
paragraph and insert:
"SECTION 1. IC 2-3-10-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.181-2017,
SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 2. A member of the general assembly who
(1) possesses a valid Indiana license to carry a handgun; and
(2) is otherwise permitted to possess a handgun;
is not prohibited under state or federal law from possessing a
handgun has the right to carry a handgun within the state capitol
building and on the property of the state capitol complex.
SECTION 2. IC 2-3-10-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.181-2017,
SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 3. (a) Subject to governing authority rules and
policies concerning personnel practices, a member of the professional
staff of the general assembly who
(1) possesses a valid Indiana license to carry a handgun; and
(2) is otherwise permitted to possess a handgun;
is not prohibited under state or federal law from possessing a
handgun has the right to carry a handgun within the state capitol
building and on the property of the state capitol complex.
(b) A member of the Indiana lobby registration commission
established under IC 2-7-1.6-1 who
(1) possesses a valid Indiana license to carry a handgun; and
(2) is otherwise permitted to possess a handgun;
is not prohibited under state or federal law from possessing a
handgun has the right to carry a handgun within the state capitol
building and on the property of the state capitol complex.".
