I	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6552, sub-§2, ¶D is enacted to read:
3 4 5	D. The prohibition on discharge of a firearm does not apply to a person residing on private property who discharges a firearm on the private property in self-defense or in order to protect the person's residence.
6	SUMMARY
7 8 9 10	Current law prohibits a person from discharging a firearm within 500 feet of public school property or the property of an approved private school. This bill establishes an exception for the discharge of a firearm by a person residing on private property for the purposes of self-defense or in order to protect the person's residence.
