An Act to Enhance Privacy and Prohibit Shipping Companies from Maintaining Records of Firearm and Ammunition Shipments

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2015 is enacted to read:

§2015. Common carrier and contract carrier firearms or firearms owner record, registry or database prohibited

- 1. Prohibition. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a common carrier or contract carrier for transportation or shipment may not keep or cause to be kept a record, registry or database of privately owned firearms in this State; a record, registry or database of firearm owners in this State; or a record, registry or database of firearm possessors in this State that contains sufficient information to establish a connection between any specific sender or receiver of a shipment in this State containing a firearm or firearm ammunition, including, but not limited to, information regarding the name and address of an individual and information regarding the make, model, caliber or serial number of a firearm.
- 2. Penalty. A common carrier or contract carrier for transportation or shipment that violates subsection 1 commits a civil violation for which a fine of \$1,000 for each item of information stored in a record, registry or database in violation of subsection 1 must be adjudged.

18 SUMMARY

This bill makes it unlawful for common carriers or contract carriers for transportation or shipment to maintain a record, registry or database containing information relating to firearms, firearm owners and firearm possessors that would be sufficient to establish a connection between any person and any specific firearm or firearm ammunition. The penalty for violating this law is a civil violation for which a fine of \$1,000 must be adjudged for each item of information stored in a record, registry or database by a common carrier or contract carrier for transportation or shipment.
