1 (a) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A permit 2 expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following 2 years after the date the 3 permit is issued.

4 (D) THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH AN ALTERNATIVE EXPIRATION DATE 5 FOR A PERMIT TO COINCIDE WITH THE EXPIRATION OF A LICENSE OR COMMISSION 6 FOR:

7 (1) A PRIVATE DETECTIVE UNDER TITLE 13 OF THE BUSINESS 8 OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE;
