10	of 1971; clarifying manner in which a loaded or unloaded firearm may be carried without a license;

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, as
16	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2016 (21 O.S. Supp.
17	2018, Section 1289.6), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1289.6
19	CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIREARMS MAY BE CARRIED
20	A. A person shall be permitted to carry loaded and unloaded
21	shotguns, rifles and pistols <del>, open and not concealed and</del> without a
22	handgun license <del>as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act</del>
23	pursuant to the following conditions:
24	1. When hunting animals or fowl;

During competition in or practicing in a safety or hunter
 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized
 sporting events;

4 3. During participation in or in preparation for a military 5 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve federal 6 7 military reserve and active military forces. It is further provided that Oklahoma Army or Air National Guard personnel with proper 8 9 authorization and performing a military function may carry loaded or 10 unloaded and concealed weapons on Oklahoma Military Department 11 facilities in accordance with rules promulgated by the Adjutant 12 General:

13 4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized 14 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as 15 functioning police officials;

16 5. During a practice for or a performance for entertainment 17 purposes;

For lawful self-defense and self-protection or any other
 legitimate purpose in or on property that is owned, leased, rented,
 or otherwise legally controlled by the a person; or

7. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
Firearms Act of 1971 or any legislative enactment regarding the use,
ownership and control of firearms.

B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,
 rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a handgun
 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to
 the following conditions:

5 1. When going to or from the person's private residence or 6 vehicle or a vehicle in which the person is riding as a passenger to 7 a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs or 8 reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or gunsmith, 9 or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or target 10 shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized firearms 11 activity or event and while in such places; or

For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
 Firearms Act of 1971.

14 C. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to 15 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions, 16 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns 17 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the 18 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
