13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 25 of Title 51, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. As used in this section:
17	1. "Public officer" means any public official or any employee
18	of a law enforcement agency as defined in Section 24A.3 of Title 51
19	of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
20	2. "Gun control policy" means a set of laws or policies that
21	regulate the manufacture, sale, transfer, possession, modification,
22	or use of firearms by civilians.
23	B. A public officer or the employees of a public officer shall

not use public monies or cause public monies to be used for the

advocacy or promotion of gun control policy and shall be specifically prohibited from doing any of the following:

- 1. Using publicity or propaganda for purposes of advocating or promoting gun control policy or preparing, distributing, or using any kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication, or radio, television, or video presentation designed to support or defeat the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or administrative action relating to gun control policy;
- 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or administrative action relating to gun control policy; or
- 3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending, or future federal, state, or local tax increase relating to gun control policy, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement or restriction on any legal consumer product including the sale and marketing of the legal consumer product relating to the advocacy or promotion of gun control policy.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
