13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 4210.3, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 4210.3. It shall be unlawful to transport a shotgun,
16	rifle or pistol in or to discharge such weapons <u>a firearm</u> from a
17	vessel $_{m{ au}}$ except for the purposes of self-defense, hunting animals or
18	fowl, and in compliance with existing state and federal laws.
19	Anyone violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction,
20	shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine \overline{of}
21	not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than One Hundred
22	Dollars ($\$100.00$), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not
23	less than ten (10) days and not more than six (6) three (3) months,
24 2 -	or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person in possession of

1	a valid handgun license from this state or a reciprocal state
2	authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not be deemed
3	guilty of transporting a pistol in violation of this section when a
4	handgun is carried concealed or unconcealed upon or about their
5	person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-
6	Defense Act.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
