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- 2. A firearm suppressor manufactured and sold in this state must have the words "Made in Oklahoma" clearly stamped, machined, or engraved on it.
- B. For purposes of this section, a firearm suppressor is manufactured in this state if the item is manufactured:
 - 1. In this state from basic materials; and

- 2. Without the inclusion of any part imported from another state other than a generic and insignificant part as defined in this section.
- C. For purposes of this section, a firearm suppressor is manufactured in this state if it is manufactured without regard to whether a firearm imported into this state from another state is attached to or used in conjunction with the suppressor.
- D. No agency, municipality, or other political subdivision shall adopt a rule, order, ordinance, or policy under which the entity enforces order, rule, or regulation that purports to regulate a firearm suppressor if the statute, order, rule, or regulation imposes a prohibition, restriction, or other regulation that does not exist under the laws of this state.
 - E. As used in this section:
- 1. "Firearm" shall have the same definition as provided in Section 1289.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 2. "Firearm suppressor" means any device designed, made, or adapted to muffle the report of a firearm;

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3. "Generic and insignificant part" means an item that has
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    manufacturing or consumer product applications other than inclusion
    in a firearm suppressor. The term includes but is not limited to a
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    spring, screw, nut, or pin; and
        4. "Manufacture" includes forging, casting, machining, or
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    another process for working a material.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
