Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of

Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general law whose

On page 2, after line 2, add the following language:

purpose or effect would be to require a new or increased

expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard

to a local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote

unless: it comes within one of a number of specified

exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the

Legislature appropriates funds, or provides a local source of

revenue, to the entity for the purpose.

The purpose or effect of this bill would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, the bill does not require approval of a local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective because it comes within one of the specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

On page 2, line 14, after "purpose" insert the following:

; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended

On page 10, after line 21, insert a new Section 10 and renumber the subsequent section accordingly:

Section 10. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, as amended by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.
