A RESOLUTION

1 Encouraging Congress to pass the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act or a similar bill.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States provides
that "the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed"; and

5 WHEREAS the United States Supreme Court has a history of protecting the right of 6 individual citizens to bear arms as provided in the Second Amendment to the Constitution of 7 the United States; and

8 WHEREAS, in District of Columbia v. Heller, 554 U.S. 570 (2008), the United States 9 Supreme Court held that the Second Amendment protects an individual right to possess a 10 firearm unconnected with service in a militia, and to use that arm for traditionally lawful 11 purposes, such as self-defense within the home; and

- WHEREAS art. I, sec. 19, of the Constitution of the State of Alaska provides that "[t]he individual right to keep and bear arms shall not be denied or infringed by the State or a political subdivision of the State"; and
- WHEREAS, where it is legal to do so, a person who is 21 years of age or older and who may legally possess a firearm may carry a firearm in the state without a concealed carry

1 permit; and

2 WHEREAS the state issues permits to carry a concealed handgun as provided in
3 AS 18.65.700 - 18.65.790; and

4 **WHEREAS** art. IV, sec. 1, of the Constitution of the United States provides that 5 every state shall give full faith and credit to the judicial proceedings and documents of every 6 other state and that Congress may determine how those documents will be recognized; and

WHEREAS, under art. IV, sec. 1, Constitution of the United States, states provide
reciprocity for legally issued driver's licenses from other states; and

9 WHEREAS states that issue concealed carry permits restrict eligibility to persons
10 who are eligible under federal and state laws to legally possess a firearm; and

WHEREAS states that issue concealed carry permits require the applicant to complete a handgun competency course and display the applicant's ability and knowledge of related responsibilities to legally operate a firearm; and

WHEREAS states that issue concealed carry permits require applicants to submit
 fingerprints and pass a criminal background check; and

16 WHEREAS 19 states currently provide reciprocity for concealed carry permits issued
 17 in other states;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests that the United States Congress pass legislation that amends the federal criminal code to allow an individual qualified to carry or possess a concealed handgun in one state to carry or possess a concealed handgun in another state that also allows individuals to carry concealed firearms; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature encourages the United States Congress to pass the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act (H.R. 38) from the 117th Congress or a similar bill; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests that the President of the United States sign into law legislation passed by Congress that enacts the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act (H.R. 38) from the 117th Congress or a similar bill.
