- 6 August 31, 2019, estimated to be \$19,000,000, is appropriated from that fund to the
- 7 Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for capital project grants
- 8 under the National Petroleum Reserve Alaska impact grant program.
- * Sec. 9. LAPSE. (a) The appropriations made in secs. 3, 4, 6(2), and 7 of this Act are for capital projects and lapse under AS 37.25.020.
