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27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-101, concerning definitions used for
30	weapons offenses, is amended to add an additional definition to read as
31	follows:
32	(11) "Collegiate athletic event" means a sporting or athletic
33	contest, event, or practice of an individual or team of individuals in which
34	one (1) or more individuals or team of individuals sponsored by, funded by,
35	represented by or associated with a public or private university, college, or
36	<u>community college competes against itself or another individual or team of</u>



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1 individuals sponsored by, funded by, represented by or associated with a 2 public or private university, college, or community college; (12)(A) "Public teaching hospital" means a publicly funded institution 3 4 of higher education that also includes a hospital or other facility where 5 health care is administered either in an instructional setting or in another 6 setting. 7 (B) "Public teaching hospital" includes without limitation 8 the premises and buildings of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences 9 and the Arkansas State Hospital. 10 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-122, as amended by Acts 2017, No. 562, 11 12 is amended to read as follows: 13 5-73-122. Carrying a firearm in publicly owned buildings or 14 facilities. 15 (a)(1) Except as provided in <u>§§</u> 5-73-322 and § 5-73-306, it is 16 unlawful for any person other than a law enforcement officer or a security 17 guard in the employ of the state or an agency of the state, or any city or 18 county, or any state or federal military personnel, to knowingly carry or 19 possess a loaded firearm or other deadly weapon in any publicly owned 20 building or facility or on the State Capitol grounds. 21 (2) It is unlawful for any person other than a law enforcement 22 officer or a security guard in the employ of the state or an agency of the 23 state, or any city or county, or any state or federal military personnel, to 24 knowingly carry or possess a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded, in the 25 State Capitol Building or the Justice Building in Little Rock. 26 (3) However, this subsection does not apply to a person carrying 27 or possessing a firearm or other deadly weapon in a publicly owned building 28 or facility or on the State Capitol grounds: 29 (A) For the purpose of participating in a shooting match 30 or target practice under the auspices of the agency responsible for the 31 publicly owned building or facility or State Capitol grounds; 32 (B) If necessary to participate in a trade show, exhibit, or educational course conducted in the publicly owned building or facility or 33 34 on the State Capitol grounds; 35 (C)(i) If the person has a license to carry a concealed 36 handgun under § 5-73-301 et seq. and is carrying a concealed handgun in his

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1 or her motor vehicle or has left the concealed handgun in his or her locked 2 and unattended motor vehicle in a publicly owned and maintained parking lot. 3 (ii)(a) As used in this subdivision (a)(3)(C), 4 "parking lot" means a designated area or structure or part of a structure 5 intended for the parking of motor vehicles or a designated drop-off zone for 6 children at school. 7 (b) "Parking lot" does not include a parking 8 lot owned, maintained, or otherwise controlled by the Department of 9 Correction or Department of Community Correction; 10 (D) If the person has completed the required training and 11 received a concealed carry endorsement under § 5-73-322(g) and the place is 12 not a: 13 *(i) Courtroom or the location of an administrative* 14 hearing conducted by a state agency, except as permitted by § 5-73-306(5) or 15 (6) § 5-73-306(6); 16 (ii) Public school kindergarten through grade twelve 17 (K-12) or a public prekindergarten, except as permitted under subdivision 18 (a)(3)(C) of this section; or 19 (iii) A facility operated by the Department of 20 Correction or the Department of Community Correction; or 21 (iv) Place owned by, operated by, administered by, 22 or associated in a clinical setting with a public teaching hospital; or 23 (v) Place that is hosting or being used for a 24 collegiate athletic event; or 25 (E) If the person has a license to carry a concealed handgun 26 under § 5-73-301 et seq., is a justice of the Supreme Court or a judge on the 27 Court of Appeals, and is carrying a concealed handgun in the Justice 28 Building. 29 (4) As used in this section, "facility" means a municipally 30 owned or maintained park, football field, baseball field, soccer field, or 31 another similar municipally owned or maintained recreational structure or 32 property. 33 (b)(1) Any person other than a law enforcement officer, officer of the 34 court, or bailiff, acting in the line of duty, or any other person authorized 35 by the court, who possesses a handgun in the courtroom of any court of this state is guilty of a Class D felony, except as permitted under § 5-73-306(5), 36

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     § 5-73-306(6), or this section.
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                 (2) Otherwise, any person violating a provision of this section
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     is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
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           SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-73-301, concerning definitions involving
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     the carrying of a concealed handgun, is amended to add an additional
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     subdivision to read as follows:
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                 (7) "Private university or private college" means an institution
     of higher education that is not a public university, public college, or
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     community college as defined in § 5-73-322.
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           SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 5-73-306(17) and (18), concerning places
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     where carrying a concealed handgun by a concealed handgun licensee is
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     prohibited, as amended by Acts 2017, No. 562, is amended to read as follows:
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                 (17) Any place where a parade or demonstration requiring a
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     permit is being held, and the licensee is a participant in the parade or
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     demonstration; or
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                 (18)(A)(i) Any place at the discretion of the person or entity
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     exercising control over the physical location of the place by placing at each
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     entrance to the place a written notice clearly readable at a distance of not
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     less than ten feet (10') that "carrying a handgun is prohibited".
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                             (ii)(a) If the place does not have a roadway
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     entrance, there shall be a written notice placed anywhere upon the premises
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     of the place.
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                                   (b) In addition to the requirement of
     subdivision (18)(A)(ii)(a) of this section, there shall be at least one (1)
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     written notice posted within every three (3) acres of a place with no roadway
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     entrance.
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                             (iii) A written notice as described in subdivision
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     (18)(A)(i) of this section is not required for a private home.
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                             (iv) Any licensee entering a private home shall
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     notify the occupant that the licensee is carrying a concealed handgun.
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                       (B) Subdivision (18)(A) of this section does not apply if
     the physical location is:
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                             (i) A public university, public college, or
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     community college, as defined in § 5-73-322, and the licensee is carrying a
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1 concealed handgun as provided under § 5-73-322; or 2 (ii) A publicly owned and maintained parking lot if 3 the licensee is carrying a concealed handgun in his or her motor vehicle or 4 has left the concealed handgun in his or her locked and unattended motor 5 vehicle. 6 The person or entity exercising control over the (C) 7 physical location of a place that does not use his, hers, or its authority 8 under this subdivision (18) to prohibit a person from possessing a concealed 9 handgun is immune from a claim for monetary damages arising from or related to the decision not to place at each entrance to the place a written notice 10 11 under this subdivision (18); or 12 (19) Any premises owned or operated by a private university or 13 private college unless the private university or private college permits a 14 licensee to carry a concealed handgun on the premises 15 16 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 5-73-322(c)(2), as amended by Acts 2017, 17 No. 562, is amended to read as follows: 18 (2)(A) A private university or private college that adopts a 19 policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the 20 buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college 21 shall post notices as described in § 5-73-306(18). 22 (B) A private university or private college that adopts a 23 policy only allowing carrying of a concealed handgun under this section shall may post notices as described in § 5-73-306(18) and subdivision 24 25 $\frac{(c)(1)(C)}{(c)(1)(B)}$ of this section. 26 (C)(B) If a private university or private college permits 27 carrying a concealed handgun under this section, the private university or 28 private college may revise any sign or notice required to be posted under § 29 5-73-306(18) to indicate that carrying a concealed handgun under this section 30 is permitted. 31 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 5-73-322(j)(3), concerning immunity of a 32 33 public university, public college, or community college, as amended by Acts 34 2017, No. 562, is amended to read as follows: 35 (3) A public university, public college, or community college is 36 immune from a claim for monetary damages arising from or related to a

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1	licensee's use of, or failure to use, a concealed handgun, if the licensee is
2	employed by the public university, public college, or community college
3	against whom the claim is filed and <u>if</u> the licensee elects to possess the <u>a</u>
4	concealed handgun under this section.
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6	SECTION 7. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Effective date.</u>
