An act to amend Section 28100 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 612, as introduced, Nazarian. Vehicle: pilot cars.

Existing law requires a pilot car, which is a vehicle that escorts oversized or special load vehicles, to display at least one red warning flag on each side of the vehicle and requires the flags to be a minimum of 16 inches square and visible from both the front and rear of the vehicle.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change in that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28100 of the Vehicle Code is amended
- 2 to read:
- 3 28100. A pilot car shall display at least one red warning flag
- 4 on each side of the vehicle. The flags shall be a minimum of 16
- 5 inches square, and shall be ~~mounted so as to be~~ visible from both

- 1 the front and rear of the vehicle. The flags shall be removed or
- 2 covered when the vehicle is not operating as a pilot car.
