- 4 "(2) (a) Violation of a protection order is a class 2 misdemeanor; 5 except that:
 - (I) If the restrained person has previously been convicted of violating this section or a former version of this section or an analogous municipal ordinance, or if the protection order is issued pursuant to section 18-1-1001, the violation is a class 1 misdemeanor; OR
- (II) IF THE RESTRAINED PERSON WHILE IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM COMES WITHIN A SPECIFIED DISTANCE OF THE PROTECTED PERSON IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE VIOLATION IS A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR AND THE COURT SHALL SENTENCE THE DEFENDANT TO A MANDATORY MINIMUM SENTENCE OF EIGHTEEN MONTHS IN THE COUNTY JAIL.".
