# A BILL FOR AN ACT

# 101 CONCERNING SECURITY FOR THE COLORADO GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

# **Bill Summary**

The bill requires the Colorado state patrol to:

- ! Provide protection for members of the general assembly when they are present in the state capitol buildings group;
- ! Respond to complaints relating to criminal activity or security threats against members of the general assembly;
- ! Provide adequate security for legislative buildings, grounds, and other facilities and to coordinate these security efforts with security officers of each house of the

general assembly when appropriate; and
Provide additional protection and security services as may
be required by the president or minority leader of the senate
or the speaker or the minority leader of the house of
representatives.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-33.5-216.5 3 as follows: 4 24-33.5-216.5. Patrol services furnished to the general 5 assembly. (1) THE COLORADO STATE PATROL SHALL PROVIDE 6 PROTECTION FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHEN THEY 7 ARE PRESENT IN THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDINGS GROUP AND SHALL 8 RESPOND TO ALL COMPLAINTS RELATING TO CRIMINAL ACTIVITY OR 9 SECURITY THREATS AGAINST A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. FOR 10 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (1), "STATE CAPITOL BUILDINGS GROUP" 11 SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 24-82-105 (1) 12 (a). 13 (2) THE COLORADO STATE PATROL SHALL PROVIDE ADEQUATE 14 SECURITY FOR THE BUILDINGS, GROUNDS, AND OTHER FACILITIES IN WHICH 15 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DESIGNATES AND ASSIGNS SPACE IN 16 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-2-321, C.R.S. THE STATE PATROL SHALL 17 COORDINATE SUCH SECURITY EFFORTS, WHEN APPROPRIATE, WITH THE 18 SECURITY OFFICERS OF EACH HOUSE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 19 APPOINTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-2-402, C.R.S. 20 (3) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (1) AND 21 (2) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE PATROL SHALL RENDER OTHER 22 PROTECTION AND SECURITY SERVICES AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE 23 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE, THE

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- 1 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR THE MINORITY LEADER
- 2 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.
- 3 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
- 4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 5 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
