## "AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."

- 1 Strike section 20 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
- 2 thereof:
- 3 "Sec. 20. Section 53a-217a of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):
- 5 (a) [A] Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a person
- 6 is guilty of criminally negligent storage of a firearm when such person
- 7 violates the provisions of section 29-37i, as amended by this act, and [a
- 8 minor or, a resident of the premises who is ineligible to possess a firearm
- 9 under state or federal law or who poses a risk of imminent personal
- 10 injury to himself or herself or to other individuals,] another person
- 11 obtains the firearm and causes the injury or death of such [minor,
- resident] person or any other person. [For the purposes of this section,
- 13 "minor" means any person under the age of eighteen years.]
- 14 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply if the [minor] person
- obtains the firearm as a result of an unlawful entry to any premises by

any person and, if such firearm is stolen, such firearm is reported stolen

- pursuant to the provisions of section 53-202g, as amended by this act.
- [(c) Criminally negligent storage of a firearm is a class D felony.]"
