"AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (2) of subsection (e) of section 54-142a of the
- 4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
- 5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):
- 6 (2) Convictions for the following offenses shall not be eligible for 7 erasure pursuant to this subsection:
- 8 (A) Any conviction designated as a family violence crime, as defined 9 in section 46b-38a;
- 10 (B) Any conviction for an offense that is a nonviolent sexual offense 11 or a sexually violent offense, each as defined in section 54-250;
- 12 (C) Any conviction for a class D felony offense that is a violation of section 53a-60a, 53a-60b, 53a-60c, 53a-64bb, 53a-72a, 53a-90a, 53a-103a,

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14 53a-181c, 53a-191, 53a-196, 53a-196f, 53a-211, 53a-216, 53a-217a, 53a-322,

- 15 54-251, 54-252, 54-253 or 54-254 or subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of
- 16 section 53a-189a; [or]

sections:

- 17 (D) Any conviction for a class A misdemeanor offense that is a
- 18 violation of section 53a-61a, 53a-64cc or 53a-323; or
- 19 (E) Any conviction for an offense committed with a firearm or any other firearm-related offense."
