## "AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective from passage) (a) There shall be within the
- 4 Division of State Police, within the Department of Emergency Services
- 5 and Public Protection, a state-wide firearms crimes task force for the
- 6 effective cooperative enforcement of the laws of this state concerning
- 7 offenses committed with a firearm and any other firearm-related
- 8 offenses.
- 9 (b) The task force shall be comprised of municipal and state law enforcement officers. Such task force shall be authorized to conduct any investigation authorized by this section at any place within the state as
- may be deemed necessary.
- 13 (c) The task force shall be funded by the state and supported by state 14 and municipal agencies in cooperation and assistance in the

performance of its duties, including the temporary assignment of personnel which may be necessary to carry out the performance of its functions.

- (d) The Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection may appoint a commanding officer and such other personnel as the commissioner deems necessary for the duties of the task force.
- (f) The task force shall: (1) Review the problem of offenses committed with a firearm and any other firearm-related offenses and the effects of such offenses, including on the public, and implement solutions to address such problem; (2) identify persons committing offenses committed with a firearm and any other firearm-related offenses, and focus resources to prosecute such persons; and (3) coordinate its activities with other law enforcement agencies within the state."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
