AN ACT FUNDING THE STATE-WIDE FIREARMS TRAFFICKING TASK FORCE BY REDUCING CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM GRANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to reduce Citizens' Election
- 2 Program grant amounts and that moneys equal to such reductions be
- 3 redirected to the Department of Emergency Services and Public
- 4 Protection for the purpose of restoring funding to the state-wide
- 5 firearms trafficking task force, established pursuant to section 29-38e of
- 6 the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to the state-wide firearms trafficking task force in order to reduce the number of violent gun related crimes.
