- 9 grassroots organization that advocates for rights to self-defense;
- 10 (6) [One] <u>Two</u> appointed by the minority leader of the Senate, [who]
- 11 <u>one of whom</u> shall be a representative of Hartford Hospital <u>and one of</u>
