## "AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT."

- 1 Delete lines 76 to 87, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
- 2 following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "(d) If a court determines by clear and convincing evidence that a
- 4 firearm industry member has violated any provision of section 2 of this
- 5 act, the court may award any or all of the following:
- 6 (1) Injunctive relief sufficient to prevent the firearm industry member
- 7 and any other defendant from further violating the law.
- 8 (2) Compensatory damages.
- 9 (3) Punitive damages.
- 10 (4) Restitution.
- 11 (5) Costs and reasonable attorney's fees.

12 (6) Any other appropriate relief necessary to enforce the provisions 13 of chapter 529 of the general statutes and remedy the harm caused by 14 the conduct.

15 (e) If a firearm industry member prevails in an action brought under 16 subsection (b) of this section, a court may award costs and reasonable 17 attorney's fees to such firearm industry member."
