"AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT, FIREARMS PERMITS AND ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES AND SELF-DEFENSE."

- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 18-98e of the general statutes is
- 4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
- 5 1, 2025):
- 6 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, any person
- 7 sentenced to a term of imprisonment for a crime committed on or after
- 8 October 1, 1994, and committed to the custody of the Commissioner of
- 9 Correction on or after said date, except a person who is sentenced for a
- 10 serious firearm offense, as defined in section 53a-3, or for a violation of
- 11 section 53a-70b of the general statutes, revision of 1958, revised to
- 12 <u>January 1, 2019, or</u> section 53a-54a, 53a-54b, 53a-54c, 53a-54d, 53a-55,
- 13 53a-55a, <u>53a-70</u>, 53a-70a, 53a-70c<u>, 53a-71, 53a-72a, 53a-72b, 53a-73a</u> or
- 14 53a-100aa, or who is a persistent dangerous felony offender or persistent

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dangerous sexual offender pursuant to section 53a-40, may be eligible

- 16 to earn risk reduction credit toward a reduction of such person's
- 17 sentence, in an amount not to exceed five days per month, at the
- 18 discretion of the Commissioner of Correction for conduct as provided
- in subsection (b) of this section occurring on or after April 1, 2006."
