- 3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The Special Licensing and Firearms
- 4 Unit within the Department of Emergency Services and Public
- 5 Protection shall study errors made during the criminal history
- 6 background check process, including checks that failed to identify a
- 7 disqualifying conviction due to record lapses or other system
- 8 inconsistences. On or before January 1, 2026, the unit shall submit a
- 9 report of its findings and any recommendations to the joint standing
- 10 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 11 relating to public safety and security, in accordance with the provisions
- of section 11-4a of the general statutes."
