"Sec. 501. Subdivision (2) of subsection (e) of section 54-142a of the
general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

6 (2) Convictions for the following offenses shall not be eligible for 7 erasure pursuant to this subsection:

8 (A) Any conviction, on or after January 1, 2000, designated as a family
9 violence crime, as defined in section 46b-38a;

10 (B) Any conviction for an offense that is a nonviolent sexual offense

11 or a sexually violent offense, each as defined in section 54-250;
