"AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT, FIREARMS PERMITS AND ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES AND SELF-DEFENSE."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (Effective July 1, 2025) The Commissioner of Emergency 4 Services and Public Protection, or the commissioner's designee, shall 5 study the effectiveness of gun violence prevention programs in the state, 6 including, but not limited to, any program established pursuant to 7 section 4-68cc, 19a-112i, 19a-917 or 51-9c of the general statutes. On or 8 before January 1, 2026, the commissioner, or the commissioner's 9 designee, shall report on the results of such study in accordance with 10 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint 11 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of 12 matters relating to public health, public safety and the judiciary."
