**"AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM  
INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT, FIREARMS PERMITS AND  
ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES AND SELF-DEFENSE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2025*) The Commissioner of Emergency  
4 Services and Public Protection, or the commissioner's designee, shall  
5 study the effectiveness of gun violence prevention programs in the state,  
6 including, but not limited to, any program established pursuant to  
7 section 4-68cc, 19a-112i, 19a-917 or 51-9c of the general statutes. On or  
8 before January 1, 2026, the commissioner, or the commissioner's  
9 designee, shall report on the results of such study in accordance with  
10 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint  
11 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
12 matters relating to public health, public safety and the judiciary."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
