- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. Section 46b-23 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2025*):
- 5 (a) Any person who undertakes to join persons in marriage, knowing
- 6 that he is not authorized to do so, shall be fined not more than five
- 7 hundred dollars or imprisoned not more than one year or both.
- 8 (b) Any person who undertakes to join persons in marriage, knowing
- 9 that the persons seeking to be joined in marriage are doing so for the
- 10 purposes of evading any provision of federal immigration law shall be
- 11 guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 12 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) No person may marry another
- person knowing that the marriage of such persons is for the purposes of

14 evading federal immigration law. Any person who knowingly violates

- 15 the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- Sec. 503. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2025) No person shall solicit another
- 17 person to knowingly enter into a marriage for the purposes of evading
- 18 federal immigration law. Any person who violates the provisions of this
- 19 section shall be guilty of a class E felony."
