## "AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT."

- 1 Strike subsection (d) of section 3 in its entirety and insert the
- 2 following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "(d) If a court determines by clear and convincing evidence that a
- 4 firearm industry member has violated any provision of section 2 of this
- 5 act, the court may award any or all of the following:
- 6 (1) Injunctive relief sufficient to prevent the firearm industry member
- 7 and any other defendant from further violating the law.
- 8 (2) Compensatory damages.
- 9 (3) Punitive damages.
- 10 (4) Restitution.

- 11 (5) Costs and reasonable attorney's fees.
- 12 (6) Any other appropriate relief necessary to enforce the provisions
- of chapter 529 of the general statutes and remedy the harm caused by
- 14 the conduct.
- (e) If a firearm industry member prevails in an action brought under
- subsection (b) of this section, a court may award costs and reasonable
- 17 attorney's fees to such firearm industry member."
