Remove lines 39-45 and insert:
(c) It is the intent of the Legislature to minimize the negative effects of an extended significant emergency order issued by a political subdivision. Notwithstanding any other law, a significant emergency order issued by a political subdivision must be narrowly tailored to serve a compelling public health or safety purpose. Any such emergency measure must be limited in duration, applicability, and scope in order to reduce any infringement on individual liberty to the greatest extent possible.

(d) A significant emergency order automatically expires 7 days after issuance but may be extended, as necessary, in 7-day increments for a total duration not to exceed 42 days.
(e) Upon the expiration of a significant emergency order, a political subdivision may not issue a substantially similar order.
