Section 2. Section 790.174, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

790.174 Safe storage of firearms required.-

(1) (a) A person who stores or leaves, on a premise under his or her control, a loaded firearm, as defined in s. 790.001, and who knows or reasonably should know that a minor is likely to gain access to the firearm without the lawful permission of the minor's parent or the person having charge of the minor, or without the supervision required by law, shall keep the firearm

in a securely locked box or container or in a location which a reasonable person would believe to be secure or shall secure it with a trigger lock, except when the person is carrying the firearm on his or her body or within such close proximity thereto that he or she can retrieve and use it as easily and quickly as if he or she carried it on his or her body.

- (b) A person who stores or leaves, on a premise under his or her control, a firearm, as defined in s. 790.001, and who knows or reasonably should know that a prohibited user is likely to gain access to the firearm, shall keep the firearm in a securely locked box or container or shall secure it with a trigger lock, except when the person is carrying the firearm on his or her body or within such close proximity thereto that he or she can retrieve and use the firearm as easily and quickly as if he or she carried it on his or her body. For the purposes of this section, the term "prohibited user" means any person who is prohibited by state or federal law from possessing the firearm.
- (2) Except as provided in paragraphs (b) and (c), It is a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, if a person violates subsection (1):

- (c) The penalties provided in this section do not apply if the prohibited user or the minor obtains the firearm: This subsection does not apply
- $\underline{\text{1.}}$ If the minor obtains the firearm As a result of an unlawful entry by any person.
- 2. While lawfully acting in self-defense or defense of another.
- 3. With the permission of the minor's parent or guardian and the minor uses or possesses the firearm during the minor's employment; ranching or farming; or target practice, hunting, or instruction in the safe use of a firearm.
 - (3) As used in this section act, the term:
- (a) "Locked box or container" means a secure container that is fully enclosed and locked by a padlock, key lock, combination lock, or similar locking device.
