Remove lines 14-24 and insert:

(13) (a) A person younger than 18 ~~21~~ years of age may not purchase a firearm. The sale or transfer of a firearm to a person younger than 18 ~~21~~ years of age may not be made or facilitated by a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer may not deliver a firearm to a person who is at least 18 years of age

22 (e) The prohibitions of this subsection do not apply to
23 the purchase of a rifle or shotgun by a law enforcement officer
24 or correctional officer, as those terms are defined in s.
25 943.10(1), (2), (3), (6), (7), (8), or (9), or a servicemember
26 as defined in s. 250.01.
