7 790.065 Sale and delivery of firearms.—

8 (13) A person younger than 21 years of age may not  
9 purchase a firearm. The sale or transfer of a firearm to a  
10 person younger than 21 years of age may not be made or  
11 facilitated by any person a licensed importer, licensed  
12 ~~manufacturer, or licensed dealer~~. A person who violates this  
13 subsection commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as

14 provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. The  
15 prohibitions of this subsection do not apply to the purchase of  
16 a rifle or shotgun by a law enforcement officer or correctional

18 (6), (7), (8), or (9), or a servicemember as defined in s.  
19 250.01.
