A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to require that a gun lock be furnished
to the buyer in all retail firearm sales made by firearm dealers; to provide for criminal
penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1. 6 7 Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 8 relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as 9 follows: 10 ″<u>16-11-172.1.</u> 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'gun lock' means a device that, when installed on a firearm, is designed to prevent the firearm from being operated without first 12 13 deactivating the device. 14 (b) A gun lock shall be furnished by a dealer to the buyer with each retail sale of a firearm 15 made by such dealer. Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor." 16
