A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 15-12-71, Title 16, and Code Section 17-7-52 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to duties of grand jury, crimes and offenses, and procedure for indictment or special presentment of peace officer for crime in performance of duties, notification, and rights of officer, respectively, so as to repeal the provision regarding no duty to retreat prior to the use of force; to correct cross-references; to repeal the defense of self or others as an absolute defense; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Code Section 15-12-71 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to duties of grand
jury, is amended by revising subparagraph (b)(5)(E) as follows:

"(E) Prior to the introduction of any evidence or the first witness being sworn, the
district attorney shall advise the grand jury of the laws applicable to the conduct of such
review. In particular, the grand jury shall be advised of Code Sections 16-3-20,
16-3-21, 16-3-23.1, and 17-4-20."

SECTION 2.

S. B. 135 - 1 - 20

17 Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to crimes and offenses, is 18 amended by repealing in its entirety Code Section 16-3-23.1, relating to no duty to retreat

19 prior to the use of force in self-defense.

Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 16-3-24.2, relating to immunity from
prosecution, as follows:

SECTION 3.

23 "16-3-24.2.

A person who uses threats or force in accordance with Code Section 16-3-21, 16-3-23,

25 16-3-23.1, or 16-3-24 shall be immune from criminal prosecution therefor unless, in the use

of deadly force, such person utilizes a weapon, the carrying or possession of which is

27 unlawful by such person under Part 2 or 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of this title."

28 SECTION 4.

29 Said title is further amended by repealing in its entirety Code Section 16-11-138, relating to

30 defense of self or others as absolute defense.

SECTION 5.

Said title is further amended by repealing in its entirety Code Section 16-12-129, relating to
defense of self or others an absolute defense to a violation under Part 2 of Article 4 of
Chapter 12 of this title.

SECTION 6.

36 Code Section 17-7-52 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to procedure for

37 indictment or special presentment of peace officer for crime in performance of duties,

38 notification, and rights of officer, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

39 "(c) Prior to the introduction of any evidence or the first witness being sworn, the 40 prosecuting attorney shall advise the grand jury of the laws applicable to the conduct of 41 such proceedings, all relevant sections of the Code relating to the crime or crimes alleged 42 in the bill of indictment, and any Code section that excuses or justifies such conduct. In 43 particular, the grand jury shall be advised of Code Sections 16-3-20, 16-3-21, 16-3-23.1, 44 and 17-4-20."

SECTION 7.

46 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
