A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to exempt sales of firearms, ammunition, gun
- 3 safes, trigger locks, and related accessories during a five-day period each year; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to provide for automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 9 sales and use taxes, is amended by revising paragraph (85) as follows:
- 10 "(85) For five days beginning on the second Friday of October each year, sales of
- firearms, ammunition, gun safes, trigger locks, and related accessories, including, but
- not limited to, stocks, barrels, scopes, and magazines Reserved;"

SECTION 2.

14 This Act shall stand repealed on June 30, 2029.

15 **SECTION 3.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 16
