A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to require a three-day waiting period for
- 3 the purchase or transfer of certain firearms; to provide for inspection; to provide for
- 4 exceptions; to provide for criminal penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "16-11-172.1.
- 12 (a) No purchase or transfer of a firearm conducted by a licensed importer, licensed
- manufacturer, or licensed dealer shall be completed until the third day after the initiation
- of such purchase or transfer; provided, however, that the calculation of the three days shall
- not include Saturdays, Sundays, or state or federal holidays and provided, further, that the

NICS check provided for under Code Section 16-11-172 may be conducted within the three

- 17 days.
- 18 (b) Licensed importers, licensed manufacturers, and licensed dealers shall, during normal
- business hours, make records available for inspection by any law enforcement agency for
- 20 purposes of any criminal investigation.
- 21 (c) Subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply when a firearm is being purchased
- by or transferred to:
- 23 (1) The holder of a weapons carry license issued pursuant to Code Section 16-11-129;
- 24 <u>or</u>
- 25 (2) Any person provided for under Code Section 16-11-130.
- 26 (d) Any licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer that violates this Code
- 27 <u>section, or any purchaser or transferee who uses fraud or false representation to avoid the</u>
- 28 requirements of subsection (a) of this Code section, shall be guilty of a felony and, upon
- 29 conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five
- 30 years."

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
