## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia

4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

- 16 <u>obtain the firearm shall be guilty of the offense of failure to adequately secure a firearm</u>
- 17 when the firearm is obtained by:
- 18 (1) A minor and exhibited in a public place or while making a threat of violence; or
- 19 (2) Any individual, regardless of age, and used during the commission of a crime or
- 20 during an act which results in the injury or death of such individual or another when such
- 21 act was not the lawful defense of people or property.
- 22 (c) A violation of this Code section shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less
- 23 <u>than \$500.00."</u>

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
