## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 16-11-129 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	license to carry weapon, temporary renewal permit, and mandamus, so as to provide that all
3	records of the judge of probate court regarding weapons carry licenses shall be confidential
4	and not open to public inspection and shall not be disclosed; to provide for exceptions; to
5	provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
6	other purposes.
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
8	SECTION 1.
9	Code Section 16-11-129 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to license to
10	carry weapon, temporary renewal permit, and mandamus, is amended by adding a new
11	subsection to read as follows:
12	"(k) All records of the judge of probate court regarding weapons carry licenses and other
13	records regarding the possession of firearms shall be confidential and shall not be open to
14	public inspection or disclosure, except to the extent that such records relating to licensing
15	and possession of firearms are sought by law enforcement agencies as provided by law."
16	<b>SECTION 2.</b>
17	This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
18	without such approval.

20	SECTION 3.
21	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
