

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$262,500, or so much thereof as may  
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Commitment to Human  
7 Services Fund to the Department of Transportation for a grant  
8 to the Illinois Latino Family Commission for the costs  
9 associated with the assisting State agencies in developing  
10 programs, services, public policies and research strategies  
11 that will expand and enhance the social and economic well-  
12 being of Latino children and families.
