DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 24-4-20.

Synopsis: Retail sales of Tannerite. Regulates the retail sale of Tannerite, a patented ammonium nitrate and aluminum powder based binary explosive used primarily as a target for firearms practice. Provides that a retailer: (1) must secure Tannerite behind a counter or in a locked display case so that Tannerite is unavailable to a customer without the assistance of the retailer or an employee of the retailer; (2) may not sell Tannerite to a customer who is less than 18 years of age; and (3) must verify the age of a customer who wishes to purchase Tannerite by requiring the customer to produce a valid government issued photographic identification card that shows the date of birth of the customer. Makes it a Class C infraction for a person to violate the law concerning the retail sale of Tannerite.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning trade regulation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

5	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "binary explosive" means an
6	explosive that consists of two (2) components, neither of which is
7	explosive by itself, that must be mixed together to become
8	explosive.
9	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "retailer" means a person who
0	sells or otherwise distributes Tannerite for consideration to an end
1	user in Indiana.
2	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "Tannerite" means a patented
3	ammonium nitrate and aluminum powder based binary explosive
4	used primarily as a target for firearms practice.
5	Sec. 4. A retailer must secure Tannerite:
6	(1) behind a counter; or



1	(2) in a locked display case;
2	so that Tannerite is unavailable to a customer without the
3	assistance of the retailer or an employee of the retailer.
4	Sec. 5. (a) A retailer may not sell Tannerite to a customer who
5	is less than eighteen (18) years of age.
6	(b) Before a retailer sells Tannerite to a customer, the retailer
7	must verify the age of the customer by requiring the customer to
8	produce a valid government issued photographic identification
9	card that shows the date of birth of the customer.
10	Sec. 6. A person who violates this chapter commits a Class C
11	infraction.
