

HOUSE BILL No. 1387

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-47-4-9.

Synopsis: Dangerous discharge of a firearm. Provides that a person not in a place specifically set aside for the discharge of a firearm who knowingly or intentionally discharges a loaded firearm without legal justification while in a city or town commits a Level 6 felony.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

HOUSE BILL No. 1387

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-47-4-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2018]: **Sec. 9. A person not in a place specifically set aside for the**
4 **discharge of a firearm who knowingly or intentionally discharges**
5 **a loaded firearm without legal justification while in a city or town**
6 **commits dangerous discharge of a firearm, a Level 6 felony.**
