DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-24-11.

Synopsis: Indicia of firearms restrictions on license. Provides that the bureau of motor vehicles, when issuing a driver's license or learner's permit, shall place an identifying symbol in a prominent location on the driver's license or learner's permit of an individual prohibited from carrying a handgun to indicate that the individual is prohibited from carrying a handgun.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

The information must be notated in a manner 16 that alerts a person reading the driver's license or learner's permit 17 to the fact that the individual is prohibited from carrying a 18 handgun.
