DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-17.2-5-17.2.

Synopsis: Mandatory notification of the presence of firearms. Requires a child care home, if there is a firearm on the premises, to disclose to a custodial parent or guardian certain details about how the firearm is being stored. Provides that the disclosure to a custodial parent or guardian does not prevent an individual from lawfully exercising the individual's right to keep and bear arms.

Effective: July 1, 2025.

12	(3) is disassembled; or
13	(4) is not stored in any manner described in subdivisions (1)
14	through (3).
15	(b) This section does not prevent an individual from lawfully
16	exercising the individual's right to keep and bear arms.
