



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 13 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17.
- 2 Page 2, delete lines 1 through 35.
- 3 Page 3, line 7, reset in roman "IC 9-21-8-52(b)".
- 4 Page 3, line 7, delete "IC 9-21-8-52(c)".
- 5 Page 3, delete lines 17 through 42.
- 6 Page 4, delete lines 1 through 4.
- 7 Page 4, line 19, reset in roman "IC 9-21-8-52(e)".
- 8 Page 4, line 19, delete "IC 9-21-8-52(f)".
- 9 Page 6, delete lines 15 through 33.
- 10 Page 10, delete lines 19 through 25, begin a new line block indented
- 11 and insert:
 - 12 **"(18) A motor vehicle used by the owner of the motor vehicle**
 - 13 **to commit obstruction of traffic involving a rotational skid**
 - 14 **(IC 35-44.1-2-13)."**
- 15 Page 11, delete lines 31 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
- 16 insert:
 - 17 "SECTION 4. IC 35-44.1-2-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.174-2021,
 - 18 SECTION 76, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 - 19 JULY 1, 2025]: Sec. 13. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a
 - 20 person who, with the intent to obstruct vehicular or pedestrian traffic,
 - 21 obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic commits obstruction of traffic,
 - 22 a Class B misdemeanor.
 - 23 (b) The offense described in subsection (a) is:
 - 24 (1) a Class A misdemeanor if the offense includes the use of a
 - 25 motor vehicle;
 - 26 (2) a Level 6 felony if:
 - 27 (A) the offense results in serious bodily injury;

- 1 (B) the person blocks an authorized emergency vehicle (as
 - 2 defined in IC 9-13-2-6) while the vehicle is:
 - 3 (i) responding to an emergency call;
 - 4 (ii) in the pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the
 - 5 law; or
 - 6 (iii) responding to, but not returning from, a fire alarm;
 - 7 if the vehicle is using visible or audible signals as required by
 - 8 law; ~~or~~
 - 9 (C) the person obstructs the entryway to a facility that provides
 - 10 emergency medical services; **or**
 - 11 **(D) the person committed the offense by operating a motor**
 - 12 **vehicle in:**
 - 13 **(i) a repeated or continuous manner with the intent of**
 - 14 **causing the vehicle to perform a rotational skid; and**
 - 15 **(ii) a manner that endangered a person; and**
 - 16 (3) a Level 5 felony if the offense results in catastrophic bodily
 - 17 injury or death.
 - 18 (c) A person who unreasonably obstructs vehicular or pedestrian
 - 19 traffic commits a Class C infraction.
 - 20 (d) It is a defense to:
 - 21 **(1) an action under subsection (b) that the skid was performed**
 - 22 **in a controlled manner with the intent of avoiding a traffic**
 - 23 **accident; and**
 - 24 **(2) an action under subsection (c) that the obstruction was caused**
 - 25 **by a vehicle malfunction."**
 - 26 Delete page 12.
 - 27 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
