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AN ACT concerning oil and gas; relating to the abandoned oil and gas 1 well fund, extension; amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 55-193 and 2 3 repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 55-193 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 55-193. On July 15, 1996, and on the 15th day of each calendar 8 quarter thereafter before July 1, 2016 2023 2020, the director of accounts 9 and reports shall transfer \$100,000 from the state general fund, \$100,000 from the state water plan fund established by K.S.A. 82a-951, and 10 11 amendments thereto, and \$100,000 and \$200,000 from the conservation 12 fee fund established by K.S.A. 55-143, and amendments thereto, to the 13 abandoned oil and gas well fund established by K.S.A. 55-192, and 14 amendments thereto, except that: (a) No transfers shall be made pursuant to this section from the state general fund to the abandoned oil and gas-15 16 well fund during state fiscal year 2013, state fiscal year 2014, or statefiscal year 2015; and (b) the aggregate of the transfers made pursuant to 17 18 this section from the state water plan fund to the abandoned oil and gas 19 well fund during state fiscal year 2013, state fiscal year 2014, and state 20 fiscal year 2015, shall not exceed \$400,000 and such transfer from the state water plan fund to the abandoned oil and gas well fund shall be made 21
