AN ACT relating to weapons carried by peace officers and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

An off-duty peace officer in good standing who can provide proof of employment as a peace officer may carry concealed firearms at any location within the Commonwealth where an on-duty peace officer is permitted to carry firearms.

→ Section 2. Whereas public protection is of the highest priority, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
