1 A RESOLUTION supporting and encouraging the enactment of the federal Hearing

- WHEREAS, the Hearing Protection Act of 2017 would remove sound suppressors
- 4 from regulation under the National Firearms Act and treat them as ordinary firearms
- 5 under the Gun Control Act of 1968; and
- 6 WHEREAS, commercial manufacturers, dealers, and importers would continue to
- 7 be licensed and retail sales of sound suppressors would continue to be subject to
- 8 background check and transfer form requirements; and
- 9 WHEREAS, sound suppressors are currently subject to an application process and a
- 10 \$200 tax stamp; and
- WHEREAS, sound suppressors do not make firearms completely soundless but
- 12 possibly make them safer and quieter to operate;
- NOW, THEREFORE,
- 14 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
- 15 Kentucky:
- → Section 1. The Senate hereby supports and encourages the enactment of the
- 17 federal Hearing Protection Act of 2017 which would amend the federal criminal code to
- preempt state or local laws that tax or regulate firearm silencers.
- → Section 2. The Clerk of the Senate shall send a copy of this Resolution to each
- 20 member of the Kentucky delegation in the Congress of the United States.
